*Thank you once again for your generous offering on Easter Sunday and to all who worked so hard to make the Liturgies of the Easter Triduum a most prayerful and memorable event. Easter flies by so quickly, it is wonderful of the Church to give us 50 days to celebrate.*

*Congratulations go out to Archbishop Jose Gomez who was named Coadjutor to Archbishop Roger Cardinal Mahony of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. Archbishop Jose Gomez was the Archbishop of the Archdiocese of San Antonio in Texas. As Coadjutor, Archbishop Gomez, 58, will automatically become head of the three-county Archdiocese of Los Angeles upon Cardinal Mahony's retirement at age 75 on Feb. 27, 2011. Archbishop Gomez is the first Latino Archbishop of Los Angeles and the third Mexican native to serve as a Los Angeles bishop. Born in Monterrey, Mexico, Archbishop Gomez has served as Archbishop of San Antonio since Feb. 15, 2005 and had previously served as Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Denver since his Episcopal ordination on March 26, 2001. He was ordained a priest of the Opus Dei Prelature in 1978 and spent his early priesthood in Texas. The nation's roughly 30 million Latin Catholics -- half of them under age 25, a group expected to become the majority bloc of the 68 million-member US church within the next decade have stated that they are thrilled by Archbishop Gomez's appointment. Many happy years Archbishop, Ad Multos Annos!*


