## Fr. Corey's Comments

◆ Here is a review of the changes for the New Roman Missal. I hope I did not scare everyone the last couple of weeks with the news of the new translation of the Mass. I just want everyone on board when the changes come about. For those who have not checked the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops' website let me give you some example of what we are looking at when it comes to the new (but really the original) translation of our Mass. First, you are not going to "see" anything different. All the same parts of the Mass are there in the same order so not to worry about that. (Remember the bishops still must vote on the translation, but since the Vatican gave its "ok", it is pretty much a done deal.)

Here you can see the changes in the **People's part for the Introductory Rites**. I think many will recognize the wording for the Confiteor and the Gloria as the texts we used during the mid 60's and the exact translation of the Latin. For those of you who had a Latin/English Missal these were the words that were printed on the right of the page. As you can see the texts are much more poetic and have a deeper meaning than the language we presently use. For many, the beauty of the English language will be easily accepted and for some the beauty will take some time to get used to.

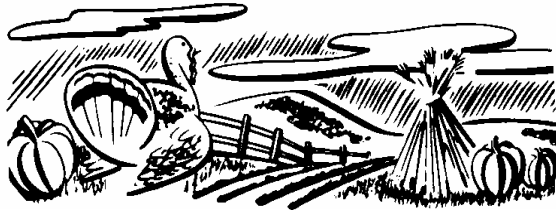
